| Essential Duties and Responsibilities | Assumes responsibility for the overall direction and management of the school facilities maintenance and operation, grounds, and planning for the future growth under the general direction of the Superintendent. Supervises custodial staff and conducts frequent inspections to ensure that the quality of cleanliness meets the district's standards. Responsible for the inventory, ordering and distribution of supplies. Creates and implements summer cleaning plans. Develops effective and efficient systems for all custodial and maintenance services, predictive maintenance, preventative maintenance, and emergency maintenance. Evaluates custodial staff. Performs a wide variety of skilled maintenance duties related to the school. Coordinates outside contractors for specialty repairs beyond his/her scope. Ensures compliance with government health and safety standards; keeps records of all permits, licenses, and inspection reports. Ensures that yearly required safety inspections are scheduled and conducted. Oversees third party vendors, i.e. snow removal, landscaping, pest control and alarm systems. Conducts key control duties. Sets up/prepares athletic facilities (indoors and outdoors) for athletic competitions; ensuring that courts, fields and the surrounding areas are clean, safe and meet all MHSAA and NFHA standards.
