School Safety Update

The School Safety Team met on March 9, 2023. We discussed the School Safety Assessment that was completed by Secure Education Consultants. In Summary, SEC believes the district has put forth effort in developing and executing safety and security plans, and it currently provides a safe and secure environment for staff and students. It was obvious to SEC that there has been thought and effort put in to successfully integrating sound physical design features with comprehensive policies and procedures. SEC commends the district on its strategy to enhance existing physical security measures and to expand on both safety and security related equipment and emergency protocol training regimens. SEC appreciates the opportunity to work with the district and hopes the recommendations found within this document contribute to these schools' safety and security initiatives.

We are also working with a company to complete Critical Incident Mapping of the buildings and grounds and to provide placards that identify rooms in the buildings. This will assist first responders in the event of an incident.

Both the Safety Assessment and Critical Incident Mapping & Placards are funded through State Safety Grants.

Appropriate Shoes for the Gym

Please make sure your students have sports-safe shoes (sneakers) at school for gym time. Elementary students are in the gym during scheduled gym and health days, as well as during inside recess. 6-12th grade could have classes in the gym, or could be in the gym during lunch.
