School Safety Updates

At Atlanta Community Schools we take the safety of your student(s) very seriously. We have been working with law enforcement on many upgrades and procedures in our building and facilities. This includes a School Safety Emergency Operations Plan, adding a School Resource Officer, providing emergency training to all staff, having a school assessment done for the building and grounds, and updating all of our mapping systems. We also have a School Safety Team that meets monthly to review procedures and current practices in school safety and plan for future upgrades and improvements. The next School Safety Team meeting is scheduled for November 7, 2023.

We have had students tamper with safety materials in the building. Please speak to your child about this. Safety is of utmost importance and any tampering with safety equipment will result in severe consequences.
